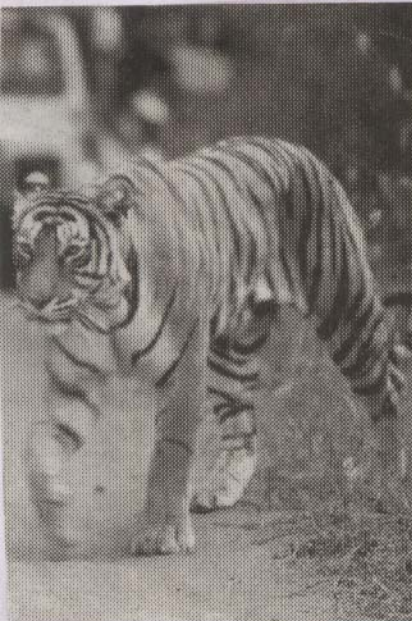

Rajasthan govt clears safe corridor for tigers

Jaipur, Jan. 4: The Rajasthan Cabinet on Wednesday gave approval to a proposal for developing Rajiv Gandhi Biosphere reserve to provide safe corridor for wildlife and conservation of tigers in the state. It was approved at a meeting of the Cabinet chaired by chief minister Ashok Gehlot here and the proposal will be forwarded to the Union ministry of forest and environment for its clearance, an official said. The reserve would cover forest blocks, water bodies, sanctuaries, national park including Ramsagar sanctuary and waterbody, Kesarbagh sanctuary, Ranthambore national park, Chambal sanctuary among others through a corridor.
