Kids for tigers

» It was a learning experience for the teachers of more than 50 schools from the City as they underwent a one-day training programme on educating kids about the environment as part of 'Kids for Tiger programme.'

In an attempt to prepare the next generation to save tigers which are dwindling in numbers, the Kids for Tigers, Sanctuary Asia and 'Save our Tigers' by Aircel had initiated a programme to train teachers who will in turn share the knowledge with their pupils.

At the day-long programme organised at Lalbagh Botanical Gardens, teachers were trained by educators and conservationists. They were taught about the connection between saving tigers, forests, rivers and climate change. The programme also provided them an opportunity to share their own concept of environment education with applicability of curriculum with conservation in the real world.
