

## 2 held with tiger skins in Amritsar

Dec. 29: Officials of Punjab's wildlife department arrested two Kanadiga women in possession of tiger skins and other proscribed animal products at Amritsar late Tuesday evening.

Geeta and Takka were nabbed red-handed as they were in the process of striking a deal with decoy customers for two Bengal Tiger skins believed to have been taken from four-year-old adult animals. The duo was also in possession of tiger claws, teeth, rare rudraksh beads and fragrant kastooris taken from musk deer.

Officials, who were tracking the women from Karnataka on a source tip off, believe the skins and other tiger parts are relatively fresh.
